



## Franklin Township Community School Corporation (#WeAreFlashes)

Marion County, IN

The Franklin Township Community School Corporation (FTCSC) engaged the AES Indiana Retro-Commissioning (RCx) Program to identify energy savings opportunities for seven of their schools, serving grades pre-kindergarten through eighth, and one administration and community education building. Project objectives focused on identifying opportunities to maximize building energy performance, while maintaining building operating conditions that support a comfortable learning environment for students and staff. The school district **achieved 124% of their energy savings goal** across two comprehensive studies performed by a local engineering partner. Across all eight sites, FTCSC improved building systems' performance and reduced utility costs, with each location realizing substantial energy savings.
